APRIL MEETING

Max Brown and Chuck Cutting gave a progress report on their upcoming "April Runabout II" Rallye. Things seem to be going very well for our annual Spring time, speed and distance rallye. It is hoped

that it will be as successful, if not more successful, than the 1st one..

New Business: Ted Long presented a tentative calendar of events for 1968. The yearly schedule includes 3 TSD Rallyes, 3 Autocrosses, a banquet at which our year-end awards will be presented and outgoing officers fested, a Christman Party, a tour, a night or gimmick (or both) rallye, and a gymkhana. The calendar, with the events proposed for each month, is as follows:

- Feb: "Icebreaker II" Autocross.
- Mar: off
- Apr: "April Runabout III" TSD Rallye.
- May: gymkhana on Sat. afternoon-evening
- Jun: tour or autocross
- Jul: night or gimmick (or both) rallye--possibly a two part rallye/autocross with SSCC
- Aug: autocross. WOW Champ.
- Sep: "September Safari III" TSD Rallye.
- Oct: autocross
- Nov: banquet
- Dec: social event

This new schedule will limit the number of events and should provide us with a schedule which will enable us to hold higher caliber events. The plan was adopted by the members present, about two thirds, and will be our tentative working schedule for 1968.

Since there was an unexpected banquet in our regular meeting room, it was unfortunately necessary that the club had to meet in the coffee shop. As a result the introduction of guests was delayed until the close of the meeting. 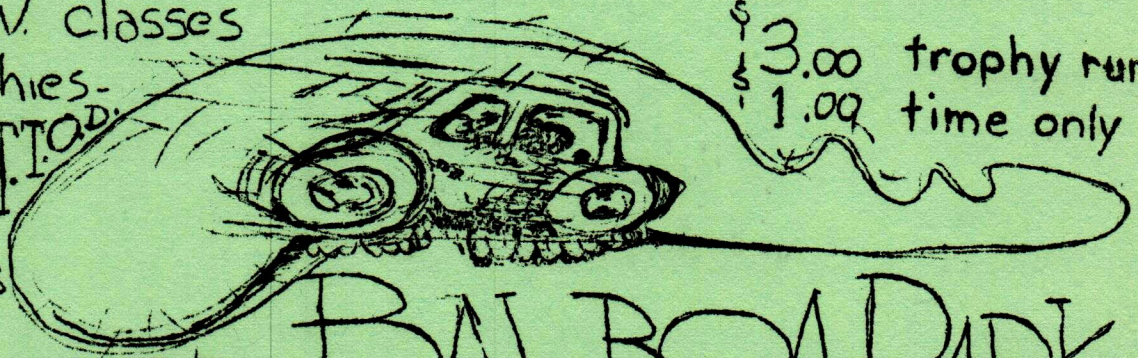
