the brakes. We got our car “raced” aligned by Greg of **Greg Cochran Motorsports** in Springfield and the 11” rims for the rear were in at **America’s Tire**. Now we needed to decide which tires to buy. People who know me know that I am a Hoosier fan but both Kumho and Hoosier came out with new tire compounds in 2004. I heard excellent reports on the V710 from the Baughs after they ran with them at Phoenix in January. The price of a complete set of Kumho V710 is about \$300 cheaper than the new Hoosier A3S04 so I thought I give the new Kumho V710 a try. The car was ready!

March finally came bringing all the rain mother nature could find but as you know we race in any weather so I was preparing myself for a little slipping and sliding if the rain came on Sunday. Saturday afternoon we did the setup for Sunday’s course with some of the normal setup crew and we also had a lot of new faces too. It looked like a nice course with a little of everything to make people happy. It was even designed for four runs in mind.

Sunday morning I got up check the weather report on the Internet and it said “Rain” but when I looked outside it wasn’t raining. Knowing Oregon I had hope for at least a dry morning when I was scheduled to run. The day turned out beautiful for all of our 154 drivers (a record number for EESCC) and with 4 runs each that is over 600 trips through the super course that was designed by Lorin Wamsley. Didn’t he do good? The fastest driver was Brad Moffett pulling a 27.959, the only 27-second run, and his co-driver, Marc Johnson was in second place with a 28.063 in the same car. The “Queen of the Event”, placing 7th overall, was Peggy Steck in our 2000 Camaro with a 29.147, wow that lady can drive! The second fastest lady was Cheryl Baugh with a 29.499 in her 2002 Corvette coming in 13th overall. I think Cheryl has finally realized what her right foot is for. The top driver, using the PAXED method, was yours truly with a paxed time of 23.346 (a raw time of 28.333 – 3rd overall) in our 2000 Camaro follow up by those Rabbit boys, Brad and Marc.
