Pinewood Derby Rules

ALL CARS MUST PASS INSPECTION TO QUALIFY FOR THE RACE


The following are in the inspection points.

1. The car weight shall not exceed 5.0 ounces. The official race scale shall be considered final.
2. The overall length of the car shall not exceed 7 inches.
3. The overall width of the car shall not exceed $2\frac{3}{4}$ inches.
4. The car must have $1\frac{3}{4}$ " clearance between the wheels.
5. The car must have $3/8$ " clearance underneath the body.
6. The wood provided in the kit must be used. The block may be shaped any way that is desired.
7. The wheels supplied with the kit must be used. The wheel may not be cut, drilled, beveled or rounded. You may remove the seam from the wheels.
8. The axles supplied with the kit must be used. They may be polished or lubricated with a dry lubricant only.
9. Wheel bearings, washers or bushings are prohibited.
10. The car must not ride on any type of springs.
11. The car must be freewheeling, with no starting devices.
12. No loose material of any kind, such as lead shot, may be used.

Each car must pass inspection before it will be allowed to compete. If you have a "Pinewood Derby Racer" from the past, either yours or your Cub Scout's, it may be used as long as it meets the above rules.
