- **COST: PER DAY-** \$25 driver. \$20 for EESCC members. \$35 if you join EESCC the day of the event. Receive a \$1 discount for a canned food donation to Food for Lane County.
- **NOTE -** We need course workers! If you want to take home the trophy you win you must volunteer to work the course during the event. Members, please help as much as possible.
