WHEN: Saturday and Sunday, May 30^{tht} and May 31^{st t}, 2009

WHERE: VALLEY RIVER CENTER NORTHWEST PARKING LOT. From 1-5 take Beltline west to Delta Hwy, go south

and take the Valley River Exit. Proceed west to Goodpasture Island Road, and then turn south onto Goodpasture Island Road until you are past the black inverted pyramid buildings, then turn right and proceed to the site. You must wear a helmet (Snell 95 or newer) in order to compete. Loaner helmets will be available if you don't own one. Real shoes are required, no sandals or flip flops. All

vehicles must pass a technical safety inspection. No loose or bungee corded batteries, solid mount only.

COST: PER DAY- \$25 driver. \$20 for EESCC members. \$35 if you join EESCC the day of the event. Receive a \$1

discount for a canned food donation to Food for Lane County.

NOTE - We need course workers! If you want to take home the trophy you win you must volunteer to work the course

during the event. Members, please help as much as possible.
