<u>DUE TO TIME AND SPACE CONSTRAINTS WE HAVE TO LIMIT ENTRIES TO 65</u>
<u>DRIVERS, SO PLEASE GET YOUR ENTRY IN EARLY.</u> If you are new to hillclimbing you will need prior solo (generally a year or so) or road racing experience, so please call if you have any questions about qualifying.

HOW TO ENTER:

You may register either on the web or by mail. To register online, see the hillclimb pages on our website <www.eescc.org>, and pay either online using PayPal, or by mailing in your check. Your payment must be received within one week to hold your pit position. ENTRY FEES:

Online registration opens May 21st and <u>will close June 24th or when entry limit is reached</u>. Register early- all fees increase after June 19th, entries paid online after that date must pay the full late fee. Mail in registration closes after June 19th. Do not mail an entry after June 19th. Call or check online for availability of openings.

SATURDAY-

IF THE FOREST SERVICE DECLARES A LEVEL III FIRE DANGER CONDITION, WE WILL START ONE HOUR EARLIER, MUST HAVE RUNS COMPLETED BY 1:00 P.M., AND WILL HAVE LUNCH LATER. (This has only happened once in the past 21 years. We will attempt to contact you in advance. **We need a current phone number &/or current e-mail info.**)

attended Friday evening's school, and still recommended).

8:00 - 8:30 AM MANDATORY Drivers' Meeting. There is NO parade lap due to safety

concerns, so review the hill before the event. The hill will be closed to competitors in the mornings at 6:30 AM for hill set up. This is for our

workers' safety.

9:00 AM First runs start!

6:00 PM Saturday No-Host Dinner plus Door Prize Drawing will be at Big Mountain

Pizza on Hwy 58 in Oakridge, a short walk from the Best Western Inn.

SUNDAY-

7:00 - 8:00 AM Any Sunday-only drivers must have car **TECHED and take a mandatory**

guided tour of the course before 8:00 AM.

8:00 AM **MANDATORY** driver's meeting.

9:00 AM Sunday runs begin!

Trophy presentation will follow the last runs on the hill.

RULES AND REGULATIONS YOU NEED TO KNOW NOW:

<u>Reminder:</u> Cars running in a class that allows racing slicks must have rollover protection even if you are not on full race slicks. All cars running in GT classes, Production classes, SPO, SPU as well as all Sports Racing & Formula Classes MUST HAVE ROLLOVER PROTECTION - A properly built and braced rollbar at a minimum - full cages advised. Rollbars are recommended for ALL classes. Also see #5 below.

<u>Also: Larison Rock Specific</u>: Any car that has an aftermarket race seat or fixed back seat installed must have a MINIMUM of a 3-point <u>harness</u> installed instead of stock belts. Also see rule #3 below.

1. All drivers must have a valid driver's license. Any license or permit which requires another licensed driver in the vehicle is not acceptable. Minor drivers must be able to show that they have permission to operate the vehicle in the event.

- 2. We have noise restrictions in place HAVE YOUR CAR QUIET!! We will be monitoring runs for noise levels. If you have questions, call ahead and ask.
- 3. All entrant cars must have seat belts and shoulder harnesses or straps.
- 4. All helmets must be **Snell 95** rated or newer. We have a few loaner helmets.
- 5. Roll bars are required in **all open top cars.** Integrated roll bar, *e.g.*, Corvette, Porsche, etc., are acceptable. Roll bars are *highly recommended in all cars*. The roll bar must be higher than the driver's head, be adequately braced, and be constructed to GCR specifications. We may request you to sit in your car at tech with your helmet on so we can confirm proper clearance. (No Scrunching down!)
- 6. Entrants must wear **LONG** sleeved shirts and long pants made of **cotton or Nomex** while driving. Nomex driving suits are **highly recommended**.
- 7. Fire extinguishers of 5BC rating or fire systems are mandatory in all cars, and unless they are Halon they must have a **CURRENT (WITHIN 13 MONTHS) tag! Extinguishers must be securely mounted to the vehicle structure with metal brackets.** We will have only a couple of suitable fire extinguishers available for you to purchase and install. Remember to be careful with fire as this event is held in the beautiful Willamette National Forest.
- 8. Driver's side window must be up during your run, or drivers must use a window net or arm restraints.
- 9. All cars must have spark arrester mufflers.
- 10. At the hill, **no smoking is allowed except** <u>inside vehicles on the paved road</u>. This is a Forest Service requirement.
- 11. Driver's meetings are **MANDATORY.** First runs may be forfeited if meeting is missed. We will have a sign in procedure.
- 12. Due to the shadows on the road it is highly recommended that the drivers use polarized sunglasses during competition runs.
- 13. No practicing on the hill before or after the event. This will be grounds for disqualification if confirmed. Speed limit in pit areas is 5 MPH. Speed limit on the rest of the hill except during timed runs is 25 MPH maximum!!

Camping will be allowed at the hill. **NO OPEN FIRES!!** The map inside the outer cover shows where you are allowed to camp, park your race car, and park your race car trailer. Please turn off generators and any other noise sources by 10:00 p.m.

HOW TO GET THERE:

Oakridge is located on beautiful Hwy 58 just 40 miles south of Eugene or 130 miles N.W. of Klamath Falls via Highways 97 and 58. **Find the map link from our website!**

To get to the hill from Oakridge go southeast on Hwy 58 to the Hills Creek Dam Road just outside of Oakridge. Then take road 21 to the west side of the lake and dam, approximately one mile, to road 2102. Then go two miles up the road to the event. Watch for 2-way traffic!
