Real shoes are required, no sandals or flip flops. All vehicles must pass a technical safety inspection. No loose or bungee corded batteries, solid mount

only.

COST: PER DAY- \$25 driver. \$20 for EESCC members. \$40 if you join EESCC the day of the event. Receive a \$1

discount for a canned food donation to Food for Lane County.
