Old Business

New Business:

Roadside cleanup - Bonnie – The August roadside cleanup date is verified for September 19th, 9am at the Hwy 58 Chevron by mile post 3.

SSL Certificate for websites – Tim Steck – asked for approval to purchase SSL certificates for both the EESCC and EEMSP websites. This will make them a secure site. It will require one certificate per site. It was approved.

2022 EESCC Officer nominations – Bren Wamsley – She asked for nominations. Keith Olsen was nominated for Vice-President. Hope Mueller was not present, so it is not known if she is going to run again. All other officer positions have the same people willing to stay in their positions.
