New Cones – Bert – he waited for Jim and Bonnie to get back to order cones. They are .60 cents cheaper if we pick them up in Portland. Bonnie said to just get the ones here in Eugene.

Evo School – Paula – She has the date for Sanderson. She was in touch with Mike Johnson and he said the date in May is fine. Her next move is to contact all the clubs she contacted last year. And maybe do another interest survey. If she can get a copy of the waitlist from last year and contact those people see if they are still interested and get club interest again. She is checking with different people and clubs to check for scheduling conflicts, so there is no instructor shortage like this year. She asked NW region if they would bring their equipment and they not appear willing. She will ask Ryan LeBlanc if he will do timing again. Bert said he could ask the viper club President if they were willing to bring their timing equipment. It was suggested that Ruben Cruz could be a contact for the Bremerton club.

New Business:

Year End Donations – Bonnie – We decided that we would donate \$300 to Candlelighters, and an additional \$300 to Food for Lane County. Guide dogs for the Blind already received \$720 from our blind autocross in April and the Oakridge firefighters have received \$1000 from the hill climb. Food for Lane County has already received a donation from the 9 events earlier

Our entry fees from the Brothers Car Collection entry fees went to Honoring Heros.US They provide assistance to veterans and active military. They sent us a nice thank you letter.

Additional Agenda Items:

Keith – He asked about coordinating a kart day. Maybe the electric karts. January or February was suggested. Bonnie said to pick some dates and bring them to the next meeting. We can invite other clubs.

Jim and Bonnie – They suggested we eliminate the Classes OPSO and OSPU. Since the creating of the DDO class, no one uses these two classes. It was voted on and passed to eliminate those two classes.

Karts – Bonnie (?) We need to set a limit of kart motor size. We had a 100CC kart get teched and it is being driven by a kid. The consensus is its too fast for our courses which is dangerous and a big liability. Our insurance has nothing on Karts. A lot of other clubs do not allow karts at all, but we do so kids over (forgot age) can participate.

Shifter karts require a 16 yr old licensed driver. (I think we said we do not allow shifter karts) SCCA removed their Jr Kart program 2 years ago.

Bonnie asked Keith to write up something that covers the rules and bring it next month so we can discuss further. Bert (I think) said he would talk to the parent with the 100CC kart.

Bonnie asked if we want to send out Christmas cards again this year and we all agreed we do. She will get them ordered.

We also got a thank you card from Food for Lane County.
