DUE TO TIME AND SPACE CONSTRAINTS WE HAVE TO LIMIT ENTRIES TO 65 DRIVERS, SO PLEASE GET YOUR ENTRY IN EARLY.

If you are new to hillclimbing you will need prior solo (autocrossing) or road racing experience, so please call if you have any questions about qualifying.

HOW TO ENTER:

You may now register either on the web or by mail. To register online, see the hillclimb pages on our **website** <www.eescc.org>, and pay either online using PayPal, or by mailing in your check. Your payment must be received within one week to hold your pit position. ENTRY FEES:

Online registration opens May 29th, closes June 28th. **Pre-registration closes on June 23rd; entries postmarked or paid online after that date must pay the full late fee.** Entries will be accepted up to the day of the event, if space is available.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

WE WILL BE STARTING EARLY, SO PLEASE READ THE SCHEDULE BELOW. (Besides, the pool is the place to be Saturday afternoon.)

FRIDAY-

- 4:00 - 8:00 PM Registration at the Best Western Oakridge Inn on Hwy 58.
4:00 - 8:00 PM Technical Inspection at Best Western Inn.
Be prepared to have your car teched off of trailer.
8:15 - 9:00 PM Drivers' School at Best Western Inn.
We will have videos, as well as suggestions on how to drive this course quickly and safely.

SATURDAY-

- 7:00 - 8:00 AM Late registration and tech at the hill. Must be there in time to have car **TECHED before 8:00 AM.**
7:30 - 8:00 AM Drivers' School for new Larison drivers (unless they attended Friday evening's school, and still recommended).
8:00 - 8:30 AM **MANDATORY Drivers' Meeting. There will be NO parade lap due to safety concerns, so review the hill before the event. The hill will be closed to competitors in the mornings at 6:30 AM for hill set up. This is for our workers' safety.**
9:00 AM First runs start!
6:00 PM Saturday No-Host Dinner plus Door Prize Drawing will be at Big Mountain Pizza on Hwy 58 in Oakridge, a short walk from the Best Western Inn.

SUNDAY-

- 7:00 - 8:00 AM Any Sunday-only drivers must have car **TECHED and take a mandatory guided tour of the course before 8:00 AM.**
8:00 AM **MANDATORY** driver's meeting.
9:00 AM Sunday runs begin!
Trophy presentation will follow the last runs on the hill.

RULES AND REGULATIONS YOU NEED TO KNOW NOW:

1. All drivers must have a valid driver's license. Any license or permit which requires another licensed driver in the vehicle is not acceptable. Minor drivers must be able to show that they have permission to operate the vehicle in the event.
2. **We have a MANDATORY noise restriction of 85 dba**, due to environmental considerations. If you have questions, call ahead and ask.
3. All entrant cars must have seat belts and shoulder harnesses or straps.
4. All helmets must be **Snell 90** rated or newer. We have a few loaner helmets.
5. Roll bars are required in **all open top cars**. Integrated roll bar, e.g., Corvette, Porsche, etc., are acceptable. Roll bars are *highly recommended in all cars*, especially modified and production cars. The roll bar must be above the driver's head, be adequately braced, and be constructed to GCR specifications. We may request you to sit in your car at tech with your helmet on so we can see that it has proper clearance.
6. Entrants must wear **LONG** sleeved shirts and long pants made of **cotton or Nomex** while driving. Nomex driving suits are **highly recommended**.
7. Fire extinguishers of 5BC rating or fire systems are mandatory in all cars, and unless they are Halon they must have a **CURRENT (WITHIN 1 YEAR)** tag! **Extinguishers must be securely mounted to the vehicle structure with metal brackets.** We will have only a

couple of suitable fire extinguishers available for you to purchase and install. Remember to be careful with fire as this event is held in the beautiful Willamette National Forest.

8. Driver's side window must be up during your run, or drivers must use a window net or arm restraints.

9. All cars must have spark arrester mufflers.

10. At the hill, **no smoking is allowed except inside vehicles on the paved road**. This is a Forest Service requirement.

11. Driver's meetings are **MANDATORY**. First runs may be forfeited if meeting is missed. We will have a sign in procedure.

12. **No practicing on the hill before or after the event. *This will be grounds for disqualification if confirmed.*** Speed limit in pit areas is 5 MPH. Speed limit on the rest of the hill except during timed runs is 35 MPH.

WHERE TO STAY:

CAMPING AND PARKING FOR RACE CARS, TRAILER, ETC:

Camping will be allowed at the hill. **NO OPEN FIRES!!** The map inside the outer cover shows where you are allowed to camp, park your race car, and park your race car trailer. Please turn off generators and any other noise sources by 10:00 p.m.

HOW TO GET THERE:

Oakridge is located on beautiful Hwy 58 just 40 miles south of Eugene or 130 miles N.W. of Klamath Falls via 97 and 58. **Find the map link from our website!**

To get to the hill go southeast on Hwy 58 to the Hills Creek Dam Road just outside of Oakridge. Then take road 21 to the west side of the lake and dam, approximately one mile, to road 2102 then go two miles up the road to the event.
