SCCA Events in Sunny California

Bonnie, Lorin and myself were back in Atwater California, for what may be the last national events that will be held there. It was the first National event for the FSP Just Ducky Focus and the first event with a real working clutch! (Thanks Brad Moffett and Phill Akins of Edge Motorsports!) Other than losing a bolt in the exhaust system that screwed up Lorin's last run on Saturday, the car ran great. As this event was really the first concrete event, as well as the first real dry event, we had to chase the handling all weekend. We realized we had too big a front bar, so we had to do some pretty drastic tire pressure changes and some shock changes as well.

Any way, Lorin and I were in the first run group and my first impression was, WOW, this car is fun. I drove like crap the first day and ended the day in ninth, but I was having too much fun to care. Lorin drove well and even with the exhaust problem was solidly in second.

It was back to the trailer, for repairs to the exhaust. I scrounged through parts bins from several competitors until I found the right bolt, and let my chief mechanic (Lorin) bash his knuckles. The car was back in tiptop shape for Bonnie's runs in the afternoon.

Bonnie went out and proceeded to humble me in the afternoon. She also put the smack down on the competition and was very comfortably in first. Not a bad first days work.

The second day Lorin was fastest in FSP for the day, but still could not overcome the first day's deficit, so he remained in second. Yours truly, moved up from ninth to fifth, which made me feel much better! Of course Bonnie widened her lead to almost four seconds in FSPL.

We took the car to Fresno for some graphics work, and boy is it racy looking now! Then it was off for a few days on a relaxing vacation to Yosemite and elsewhere in the foothills of the Sierra's. By Thursday afternoon, it was back to Fresno to pick up our baby. In addition to the new graphics, Lorin had changed the tires and put in the smaller front sway bar.

Friday we towed the Focus back to Atwater for the Pro Solo. We got the car ready and did some practice starts. The time starts when the light goes green, not when you break the beam. Start too early, and you have a DNF, start too late and you're already behind your competition. You get 12 runs, 6 per


