**SAFETY:** You must wear an approved helmet (DOT or Snell 90 or better) in order to compete. Some loaner helmets are available, but are in short supply. Shoes are also required (no sandals, open toed). Your car **MUST** be equipped with seatbelts and be in good working order (brakes, tires, etc.). No studded or temporary use tires. No loose objects in car. No loose bungee corded batteries—solid mount only.

**ALSO:** Noise restrictions are also in place for this event, set at 92dB @ 50 ft.
