Pinewood Derby Rules

ALL CARS MUST PASS INSPECTION TO QUALIFY FOR THE RACE

The following are in the inspection points.

- The car weight shall not exceed 5.0 ounces. The official race scale shall be considered final.
- 2. The overall length of the car shall not exceed 7 inches.
- 3. The overall width of the car shall not exceed 2 \(\frac{1}{4}\) inches.
- 4. The car must have $1\frac{3}{4}$ " clearance between the wheels.
- 5. The car must have 3/8" clearance underneath the body.
- The wood provided in the kit must be used. The block may be shaped any way that is desired.
- The wheels supplied with the kit must be used. The wheel may not be cut, drilled, beveled or rounded. You may remove the seam from the wheels.
- 8. The axles supplied with the kit must be used. They may be polished or lubricated with a dry lubricant only.
- 9. Wheel bearings, washers or bushings are prohibited.
- 10. The car must not ride on any type of springs.
- 11. The car must be freewheeling, with no starting devices.
- 12. No loose material of any kind, such as lead shot, may be used.

Each car must pass inspection before it will be allowed to compete. If you have a "Pinewood Derby Racer" from the past, either yours or your Cub Scout's, it may be used as long as it meets the above rules.
