Workin' in a Data Mine

(Whew about to slip down)

The eescc.org website provides result since the turn of the century, 1/1/2000 through Ice Breaker 2013. As sad as it may seem I thought this would be some "fun" data mining. After a couple/few hours I had all 13,790 rows of data each representing one entrant's day of autocross into a spreadsheet.

The first nugget I thought of was what's the total sum of autocross runs have we done?

During 116 events 50,951 runs were completed in a time of 30 days, 12 hours, 57 minutes 24.199 seconds. This is about 6.32 hours of actual run time per event.

And yes, our autocross runs average about 50 seconds, 51.788 seconds to be more or less exact. <u>Continued on page 3</u> <u>Continued from page 1</u>

The **highest attendance** at an EESCC event was 195 at the 2005 Ice Breaker.

The **lowest attendance** was 79 at the 2006 event #6 at Willamette Pass.

Average attendance is 119 entrants.

Over 1700 different people have entered EESCC events.

Drivers attending the most events including running AM and PM

- Tim Steck 124 events
- Bert Jacobsen 122 events
- David Mills 122 events
- Ryan Wamsley 112 events
- Keith Olsen 111 events

The **longest timed best run** was 142.836, I'm not going say by who or when.

The **shortest top time of day (TTOD)** was set at the 2005 Ice Breaker an NFT time by Chuck Spittal 27.37 driving a '91 Corvette. Top official time that day was a 27.474 by none other than Jerry Jenkins driving, in, yes, the red 94 Mazda Miata. That's less time than it takes to drive three laps around a skidpad.

The **longest top TTOD** was 57.382 on Bonnie's course for event #3 last year. The course was basically an entire Coca-Cola course on the south end of Coburg with the north section added on. That run was by Jason Sterner in a kart.

Classes that have set the most TTODs:

- SK & KART 20 times
- OSPU 16 times
- OSPO 11 times
- DM 11 times
- CP 7 times

Stock class cars have set TTOD three times, most recently by Tim Steck at the 2007 event 1 driving a blue 2006 Subaru STI in A stock. Is that the future Black Bomber?

Evidently rubber really does count. No street tire clad car has ever set TTOD.

45 drivers have claimed TTOD

Drivers setting the most TTODs include:

- Nathan Korstad 14 times. In his Rabbit and 12 times in that maniacal little rib bruising thing.
- Matt Dow 13 times. In OPSU, DM, and XP prepped VW Rabbits
- Marc Johnson 8 times. In an OPSU '84 VW Rabbit
- Scott Charters 5 times. In an EM '72 240z
- Bruce Schlaebitz 5 times. In the Red Devil painted yellow.

Only three drivers have set TTOD more than two consecutive times:

- Matt Dow 7 times in a row
- Nathan Korstad 6 times
- Bruce Schlaebitz 4 times
