Take exit 182 from I5 into Creswell, go west to South Mill Street right before the train tracks and go south about a block to the Mill Site. If you are caught racing or making excessive noise off the course you will be asked to leave immediately!

TIME: Registration and Tech for morning Run Groups opens at 7:30am, CLOSES at 8:30am. Registration and Tech for afternoon Run Groups opens at 11:30am, CLOSES at 12:30pm. NOVICES: If you've never run an Autocross before, a Novice class will be running all day long and we will register and tech your car during either the morning or afternoon registration sessions.

SAFETY: Your car must be equipped with seatbelts and be in good working order (brakes, tires, etc.). No studded or temporary use tires. No loose objects in car. You must wear a helmet (Snell 2000 or newer) in order to compete. Loaner helmets (sweaty and nasty) will be available if you don't own one. Real shoes are required, no sandals or flip flops. All vehicles must pass a technical safety inspection. No loose or bungee corded batteries, solid mount only.

COST: PER DAY- \$25 driver. \$20 for EESCC members. \$40 if you join EESCC the day of the event. Receive a \$1 discount for a canned food donation to Food for Lane County.

NOTE -We need course workers! Every driver (except novices) is expected to work. If you don't work then your runs will be DSQ'd (disqualified) and they will not count toward year end points. Anyone can volunteer to work, please do!

ALSO -Come early for Registration and Tech as they WILL CLOSE at 8:30 AM for the morning session and 12:30 PM for the afternoon.
