### HOW TO ENTER:

If you are new to hillclimbing you will need prior solo (generally a year or so) or road racing experience, so please call if you have any questions about qualifying. 541-485-4341

You may register either on the web or by mail. To register online, see the hillclimb pages on our website <<u>www.eescc.org</u>>, and pay either online using PayPal, or by mailing in your check. Your payment must be received within one week to hold your pit position. ### ENTRY FEES:

**Online** registration opens May 25th and <u>will close June 30<sup>th</sup> or when entry limit is reached if</u> <u>earlier</u>. **Register early- all fees increase after June 15th, entries after that date must pay the full late fee.** Mail in registration closes June 23<sup>rd</sup> - do not mail an entry after June 23rd, please go online to enter. Also, you must order your shirt by June 15th to guarantee one. A limited number of shirts will be available for sale at the hill. Non-drivers may purchase shirts also.

### SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

FRIDAY- 4:00 - 8:00 PM 4:00 - 8:00 PM 8:15 - 9:00 PM	Registration at the Best Western Oakridge Inn on Hwy 58. Technical Inspection at Best Western Inn. Be prepared to have your car teched off of trailer. Drivers' School at the Oakridge Fire Station. This school is <u>required</u> for drivers new to this hill, suggested as a refresher for all others. We will have videos, as well as suggestions on how to drive this course quickly and safely.
SATURDAY-	
7:00 - 8:00 AM	Late registration and tech at the hill. Please be there in time to have car <b>TECHED before 7:30 AM</b> . If at all possible get teched on Fri. eve.
7:30 - 8:00 AM	Drivers' School /hill ride up in truck for new Larison drivers (unless they attended Friday evening's school, and still recommended).
8:00 - 8:30 AM	MANDATORY Drivers' Meeting. There is <u>NO</u> parade lap due to safety concerns, so review the hill before the event. The hill will be closed to competitors in the mornings at 6:30 AM for hill set up. This is for our workers' safety.
9:00 AM	First runs start!
5:30 PM	Saturday No-Host Dinner plus Door Prize Drawing will be at Big Mountain Pizza on Hwy 58 in Oakridge, a short walk from the Best Western Inn.
SUNDAY-	
7:00 - 8:00 AM	Any (New to the Hill) Sunday-only drivers must have car <b>TECHED and</b> take a <i>mandatory</i> guided tour of the course before 8:00 AM.
8:00 AM	MANDATORY driver's meeting.
9:00 AM	Sunday runs begin!

### RULES AND REGULATIONS YOU NEED TO KNOW NOW: PLEASE READ THEM

This event is sanctioned by the Northwest Hillclimb Association. Please read the rules at: <<u>http://www.nhahillclimb.org</u>>, a copy will be available at tech also. \*\*\*New this year: all entrants much pay \$10 to become a <u>member of NHA</u>. They will be given NHA stickers to display on both sides of the car. Membership can be purchased at the hill or the info is on the NHA website.

\*\*\*Any vehicle coming into a National Forest can potentially bring in "invasive species" (unwanted weeds/plants). Please wash all vehicles, especially motor homes and car trailers that usually sit for a while, paying special attention to the undersides of the vehicles, before bringing them up to the hill. Thanks.

\*\*\*Also, please bring oil/fluid absorbent and sealed containers to remove any fuel or oil spills you may have in the pit area. All re-fueling is to be done on the pavement. Take precautions and remove all spills from the site, no matter how small.

\*\*\*Any car that has an aftermarket race seat or fixed back seat installed must have a MINIMUM of a 3-point <u>harness</u> installed instead of stock belts. NHA rules #Sect 5-C11, Also see rule #3 below.

- We have noise restrictions in place HAVE YOUR CAR QUIET!! We will be monitoring runs for noise levels. We will be measuring at 50' in several locations. Please have your car less than 94db at 50'. If you have questions concerning noise, call ahead and ask Bonnie @ 541-485-4341.
- 2. All drivers must have a valid driver's license. Any license or permit which requires another licensed driver in the vehicle is not acceptable. Minor drivers must be able to show that they have permission to operate the vehicle in the event.
- 3. All entrant cars must have seat belts and shoulder harnesses or straps.
- 4. All helmets must be Snell 2000 rated or newer. We have a few loaner helmets.
- 5. Roll bars are required in all open top cars. Integrated roll bar, *e.g.*, Corvette, Porsche, etc., are acceptable. Roll bars are *highly recommended in all cars*. The roll bar must be higher than the driver's head, be adequately braced, and be constructed to GCR specifications. We may request you to sit in your car at tech with your helmet on so we can confirm proper clearance. (No Scrunching down!)
- 6. Entrants must wear LONG sleeved shirts and long pants made of cotton or Nomex while driving. Nomex driving suits are highly recommended. Also must have closed toe shoes/leather recommended.
- 7. Head and neck restraints are highly recommended, such as a Hans.
- 8. Fire extinguishers of 5BC rating or fire systems are mandatory in all cars, and unless they are Halon they must have a CURRENT (WITHIN 13 MONTHS) tag! Extinguishers must be securely mounted to the vehicle structure with metal brackets.
- 9. Driver's side window must be up during your run, or drivers must use a window net or arm restraints.
- 10. All cars must have spark arrester mufflers.
- 11. At the hill, no smoking is allowed except <u>inside vehicles on the paved road</u>. This is a Forest Service requirement.
- 12. Driver's meetings are MANDATORY. First runs may be forfeited if meeting is missed. We will have a sign in procedure.
- 13. No practicing on the hill before or after the event. *This will be grounds for disqualification if confirmed.* Speed limit in pit areas is 5 MPH. Speed limit on the rest of the hill except during timed runs is 25 MPH maximum!!

### CAR CLASSIFICATION:

New this year are "Street" classes to replace the old "Stock" classes. All Stock class records are archived as of 2014. Vehicles in the "Street" classes must comply with SCCA Solo rules regarding car prep and tires. This includes, but is not limited to a minimum UTQG tread wear rating of 200. If your tires do not meet this rule, you must run an appropriate class other than "Street". Super Street-R class is the only class being carried over from the 2014 Street-R classes.

Camping will be allowed at the hill. **NO OPEN FIRES!!** Please turn off generators and any other noise sources by 10:00 p.m.

## HOW TO GET THERE:

Oakridge is located on beautiful Hwy 58 just 40 miles south of Eugene or 130 miles N.W. of Klamath Falls via Highways 97 and 58. Find the map link from our website!

To get to the hill from Oakridge go southeast on Hwy 58 to the Hills Creek Dam Road just outside of Oakridge. Then take road 21 to the west side of the lake and dam, approximately one mile, to road 2102. Then go two miles up the road to the event. Watch for 2-way traffic!
