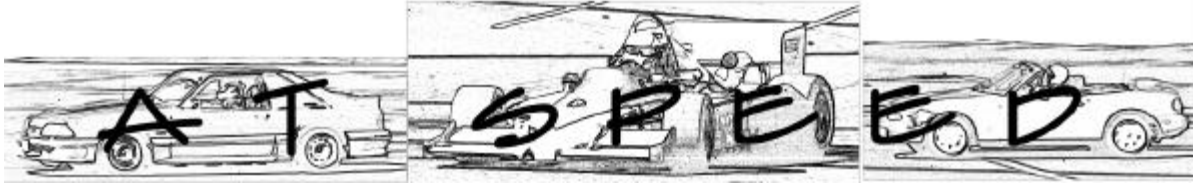

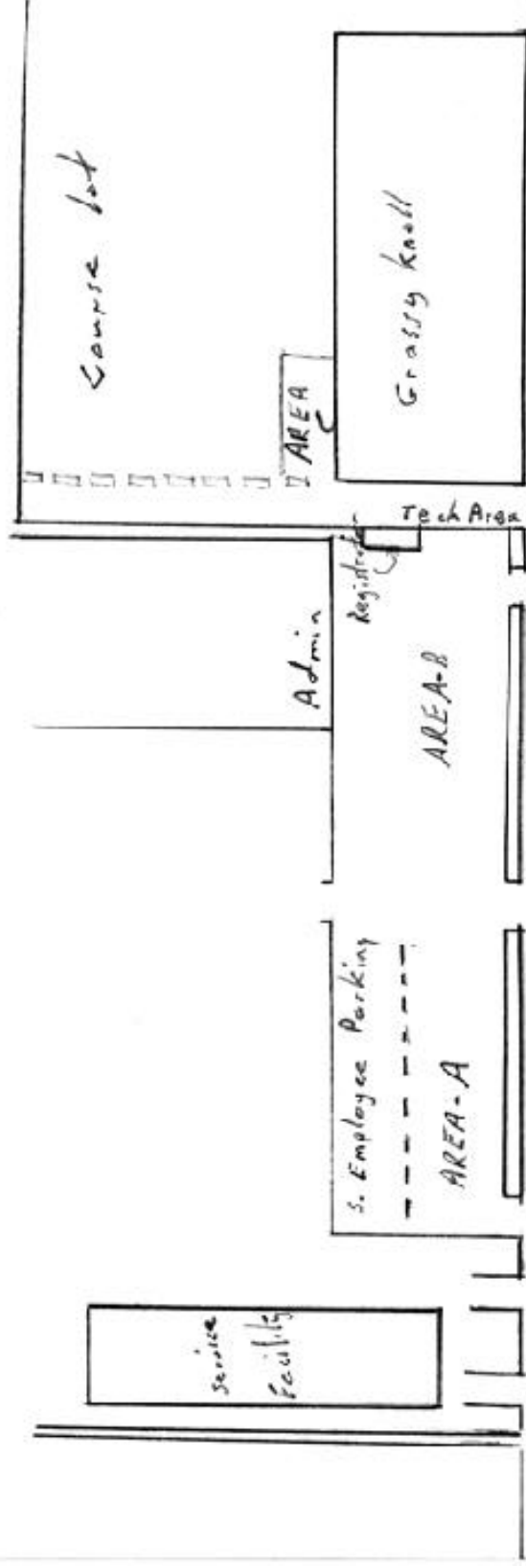


- Area-A = Parking for large tow rig & trailer combos carrying street legal cars

EESCC presents the first and second events in its 2001 Championship Autocross Series.

Please read the following information carefully. **NOTE THE NEW LOCATION AND THE REGISTRATION TIMES.**

**WHEN:** Saturday and Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2001

**WHERE:** MONACO COACH CORPORATION, 91320 Coburg Industrial Way, Coburg, OR. Exit 199 I-5 go ¼ mile west to Coburg Industrial Way, turn north and you are there. See the site map for parking instructions. No parking on the street. Please obey all traffic rules. This area will be heavily patrolled.


**TIME:** Registration and Tech for morning Run Groups opens at 7:30am, **CLOSES** at 8:45am. Registration and Tech for afternoon Run Groups opens at 11:30am, **CLOSES** at 12:45pm. Classifications will be per SCCA Solo II, and EESCC Autocross Handbook. Register at your assigned time only, per the classes below. You can register and tech for both events at once.

1:00 - 4:00      A-H & S STOCK, A-F & S MODIFIED, STREET TOURING

All times EXCEPT REGISTRATION TIMES are tentative. If you don't know which group you run come early so we can class your car, or call INFO below.

**NOVICES:** If you've never run an Autocross before a Novice class will be running all day long and we will register and tech your car during either the morning or afternoon registration sessions.

**SAFETY:** Your car must be equipped with seatbelts and be in good working order (brakes, tires, etc.). No studded or temporary use tires. No loose objects in car. You must wear a helmet (Snell  or better) in order to compete. Loaner helmets will be available if you don't own one. Real shoes are required, no sandals or flip flops. All vehicles must pass a technical safety inspection. No loose or bungee corded batteries, solid mount only.

**COST:** **PER DAY-** \$20 driver. \$15 for EESCC members. \$30 if you join EESCC the day of the event. There will also be a charge of \$1, or one can of food to be donated to Food for Lane County.

**NOTE -** We need course workers! If you want to take home the trophy you win you must volunteer to work the course during the event. Members, please help as much as possible.

**ALSO -** Come early for Registration and Tech as they **WILL CLOSE** at **8:45 AM** for the morning session and **12:45 PM** for the afternoon.

**Entry Fee (per driver):** \$15.00 / 4 runs (non-trophy, non-points, non-SCCA event)

**Registration & Tech Times:** There will be a morning run group registration time period and a separate afternoon registration time period. Groups will be formed on a first come-first served basis; 15-20 per group. Novices (first timers) are welcome and encouraged to participate!!

➤ **MORNING RUN GROUP:**

- 7:30-8:45 a.m. Registration & Tech Inspection; course open to walking
- 8:45 Drivers Meeting; Tech closed, & course closed to walking
- 9:00 First car out on course!
- Lunch (Lunch break will be right after the morning run groups are finished)

➤ **AFTERNOON RUN GROUP:**

- 11:30a.m.-12:45p.m. Registration & Tech Inspection
- \*12:00 (time approx.) Course open to walking
- \*12:45 (time approx.) Drivers Meeting; Tech closed, course closed to walking
- \*1:00 (time approx.) First car on course for afternoon session!

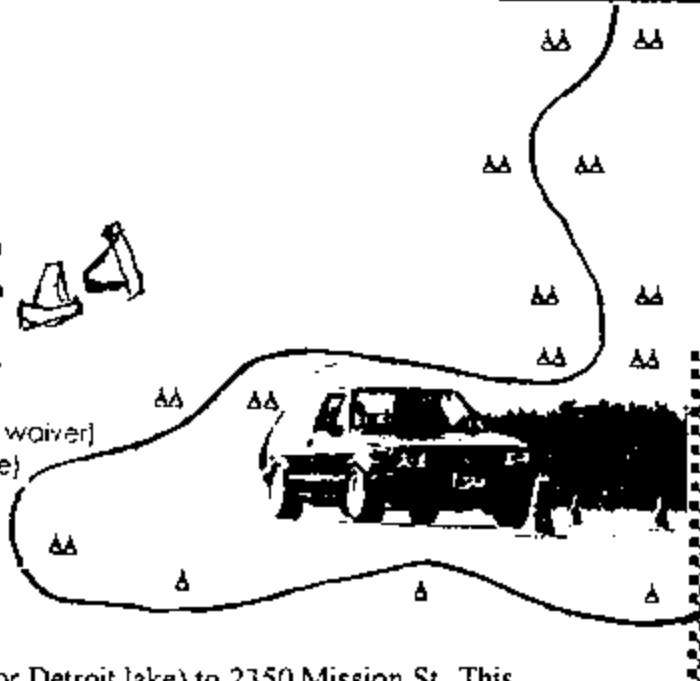
➤ *\*(Actual times for lunch break, course walk, drivers meeting, & first car out depend on when the morning run group has finished. Please adhere to this schedule so you are not late and do not miss out on the fun!)*

**AUTOCROSS:**

**will be Extreme DRIVING**

drive your car over a paved, course marked with orange traffic cones. you must try to drive quickly (on the clock) and precisely (staying on the course without knocking over cones) for 2 laps!

Take your driving to the EXTREME!



**Car and Driver must pass tech:**

- \*Parental consent for those under 18 (parent must sign waiver)
- \*Helmets required---Snell 75 or newer (loaners available)
- \*Valid drivers license
- \*Seatbelts required
- \*No loose items in/on car or engine compartment
- \*No fluid leaks (antifreeze, oil, fuel, etc.)
- \*Maximum 103 db noise limit

**Directions:** From I-5 take exit #253 west also known as (22 or Detroit lake) to 2350 Mission St. This will be on left side of street.
