Is your goal to move your competitive driving to the next level this season, but you're not sure how to do it? EESCC has the answer! Join us for this year's Evolution High Performance Driving School.

Evolution instructors are national caliber drivers with years of experience, wins, and national championships to their credit, and are trained in the Evo curriculum which is focused on making YOU a faster autocrosser. They will help you improve your driving whether you are a 16 year old novice, someone who has a year or two of auto crossing experience, or a multi-time Solo II National Champion! Building on your current level, they will help you improve your confidence and competitiveness. The intense, two-day program will challenge you, for sure, but you'll have a lot of fun, too, and come away with the skills you need to move forward with your competition goals.

The school will be held on May 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> at Sanderson Field in Shelton, Washington.

The cost is \$295 per day. Phase 1 is for anyone who has not participated in an Evo school before, and is a prerequisite for Phase 2 which builds on what you learn in Phase 1. We highly recommend attending both sessions however. You really won't want to leave! Every year we have a mixed group of first timers, and return students, and almost everyone opts to complete both days. If you have completed Phase 1, you are welcome to sign up for Phase 2, only.
